## 1 ARTICLE 14 - HOLIDAYS

<u>14.1</u> Unit members working any "A" work year shall be entitled to the following paid
holidays providing that they were in paid status during any portion of the working day
immediately preceding or succeeding the holiday, in accordance with the provisions of this
Article.

30	Governor of this State, as provided for in subsections (b) and (c) of Education Code Section	
31	37220, for a public fast, thanksgiving or holiday, or any day declared a holiday under	
32	Education Code Section 1318 or 37222 shall be a paid holiday for all employees in the	
33	bargaining unit.	
34	<u>14.3</u> When	a holiday herein listed falls on a Sunday, the following Monday shall be

deemed to be the holiday in lieu of the day observed. When a holiday herein listed falls on
 a Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be deemed to be the holiday in lieu of the day
 observed.

4 <u>14.4</u> Unit members of the District who are not normally assigned to duty during the 5 school holidays of the workday preceding Christmas Day, Christmas Day (December 25), 6 the workday preceding New Year's Day and New Year's Day (January 1) shall be paid for 7 those four (4) holidays provided they were in paid status during any portion of the working 8 day of their normal assignment immediately preceding or succeeding the recess period.

9 <u>**14.5**</u> When a unit member is required to work on any of the holidays listed in Section 10 14.1, he/she shall be paid compensation for such work, in addition to the regular pay 11 received for the holiday, at the rate of time-and-one-half of his/her regular rate of pay.

12 **14.6** Unit members working outside of their regular work year assignment meeting the 13 criteria listed in Section 14.1 will be paid for the holiday at the end of the month in the month 14 the holiday occurs or the next appropriate pay period.
